My name is Joe Turner and I recently received documents responsive to a public information request. Thank you for providing that information in a timely manner..

One of the documents I received consisted of a text exchange between Baker Tilly representative Edward Williams and Mayor Stanley. In that text exchange, Mayor Stanley asked Williams if the candidates could show up for a "private" meet and greet on Monday June 3rd at 5pm.

This would have been an hour in advance of the agenda item publicly posted on the City's website and presumably consist of the finalists introducing themselves with the entire governing body in private.

However, it is unclear if that meeting ever took place.

1. Can anyone confirm whether this 5pm private meet and greet with the two finalists took place?
2. If so, who attended or participated in this meeting?
